



Year 1 Writing Assessment

Working towards the expected standard
The pupil can write sentences after discussion with the teacher:

Date/genre:									
Compose a sentence orally before writing it									
Sequence sentences in chronological order									
Re-read what they have written to check it makes sense									
Leave spaces between words									
Use 'and' to join sentences together									
Use syllables to divide words when spelling									
Form capital letters and the digits 0-9									

Working at the expected standard – all of the above plus
The pupil can write sentences that are sequenced to form a short narrative, after discussion with the teacher:

Begin to form lower case letters in the correct direction									
Identify known phonemes in unfamiliar words									
Use the spelling rule for adding s or es for verbs in 3 rd person									
Sequence sentences to form short narratives									
Use a capital letter for names of people, places, the days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'									
Use the suffixes: s, es, ed, er and ing within their writing									
Begin to punctuate sentences using a capital letter and a full stop, question mark or exclamation mark									
Spell almost all words in Year 1 list accurately									

Working at greater depth within the expected standard – all of the above plus
