Topics For The Term

In English, we are reading Goldilocks and the Three Bears by Lauren Child. We will then explore alternative versions of this story. We will be writing from the perspective of Goldilocks, making wanted posters and publishing our own stories. We will then read 'Wolves' by Emily Gravett where we learn about fact and fiction and do our own fact finding about wolves.

In Maths, we are working on numbers to 100. This unit focuses on children's ability to read and understand numbers to 100. They will use their growing understanding of place value to help them sort, compare and order numbers. We will then move on to addition and subtraction.

Our new topic for this term is 'Horrible Histories' where we will name 'horrible' events in history, place them on a timeline and begin to understand how they have changed society. The events we will be learning about are 'The Great Fire of London and the plague', 'The Battle of Hastings' and 'The Gunpowder plot', A big well done to the children who have already started their research over the summer! Great work!
