Topics For The Term

In English, we will be reading Grandad's Camper by Harry Woodgate. The children will explore the concept of memories by thinking about how things special to them hold memories and form connections to times and events in our lives. We will then plan, draft and edit a sequel for the book. We will then be moving on to read The Owl and the Pussy-cat by Edward Lear, illustrated by Charlotte Voakein which children explore the themes of the poem, write in role as the characters, create fictitious interviews, create lists of items they can take on their honeymoon and eventually innovate upon the poem to create their own versions. In Maths, we are completing our unit on multiplication and division before moving onto length and height and then mass, capacity and temperature. We continue our topic on 'A brave new world' where we compare and contrast the main physical features of Australia and the UK.

Here are some ideas for homework to support children's learning in school.

Topic—We are continuing to learn about landscapes in Art. Can you go for a walk and take photographs of a landscape? Use your ideas from your photograph to make a collage.
