What is SEND?

Some children need extra help with:

- Learning,
- Speaking,
- Understanding,
- Behaviour,
- Physical needs.

This is called SEND.

How we notice a need

We look at:

- How your child manages in class
- Their progress
- Your views
- Your child's views
- Advice from specialists (if needed)

What happens first?

If we have concerns, we will:

- Talk to you
- Try small changes in class
- Check how things go
- Change support if needed

This is called the *graduated approach*.
